He should start, and right way, but they should have taken AARON CURRY here. This Pick could come back to haunt them, not for who they got, but rather for who they could have gotten. 67	ALEX MAGEE	PIOLI should have done his reaching/stretching exercises in the morning before the DRAFT began. Not only is this a Round too high, but I don't see how MAGEE fits a -4 scheme. He is a good, penetrating 4-3 DT. Whoops!	DL	6'3	300	PURDUE
102	DONALD WASHINGTON	His athleticism is well worth the Pick here, but hey had best be prepared to be patient. I think WASHINGTON has to learn more discipline if he is to hold his own at the Pro level.	CB	6'0	195	OHIO STATE
139	COLIN BROWN	I really don't understand this Pick. When I watched him play last season he looked massive, but slow footed and awkward at times. I did not see the talent to excel in the NFL. Bill Muir has a huge project here, in more ways than one.	OT	6'7	335	MISSOURI
175	QUINTEN LAWRENCE	OK, we finally have a selection that I like. He has speed to burn and just needs some caching and patience. He may also bring some value in the Return game. The jump from small school to the NFL may hinder any early contributions from him.	WR	6'0	185	McNEESE STATE
212	JAVARRIS WILLIAMS	This is also a solid Pick for R7. WILLIAMS is a combo RB with some speed and power. He' ll never be a starter, but he should be a nice compliment and fill in for, and supplement the JOHNSON/CHARLES tandem.	RB	5'11	220	TENNESSEE STATE
237	JAKE O'CONNELL	I've heard criticism for this selection, but I do see value in the last Round. He has good size and decent athleticism. He will block and can catch a few passes coming shallow over the middle. He should make the team and contribute.	TE	6'3	250	MIAMI (O)
256	RYAN SUCCOP	Mr. Irrelevant should have a chance to win the Kicking job in a showdown with BARTH. He has a very strong leg and may be a better weapon on KO duties than BARTH. He also brings value in his ability to Punt in an emergency. Good Pick.	K	6'2	218	SOUTH CAROLINA
