19	JEREMY MACLIN	This should be one of the steals of the DRAFT. I think he has explosive NFL potential. He should help this year in the EAGLES return game. I also see him as at least the third WR by mid-season. He should have the same kind of impact that DeSEAN had for them last season.	WR	6'0	198	MISSOURI
53	LeSEAN McCOY	He can do many of the same things that WESTBROOK does for them, so he fits their style and scheme immediately. He has good hands and will help in the short passing game. WESTBROOK turns 30 in Sept. This Pick bodes well for the future.	RB	5'10	200	PITT
153	CORNELIUS INGRAM	This is a nice gamble in R5. INGRAM is a WR who has grown into a TE. He should at least be as good as L. J. in a year or two. The only concern is whether he might miss the '09 season with a second operation on his knee.	TE	6'4	245	FLORIDA

194	BRANDON GIBSON	Had multiple QBs throwing to him, and played on a horrible team in '08. That's a bad combo for any DRAFT prospect. He displays good hands, route running ability and overall football smarts. Not a starter, but could become a viable No. 3-4 WR in time.	WR	6'0	200	WASHINGTON STATE
213	PAUL FANAIIKA	The inside version of TUPUO, with massive size and strength, if he can get his hands on someone. Looked very slow footed and lumbering to me last year. He and the coaches will have to work their butts off to develop him. I don't see it happening.	OG	6'6	330	ARIZONA STATE
230	MOISE FOKOU	Wonderful selection here in R7. He should be a kamikaze ST demon right from the start. Might have enough athleticism to get some playing time as a situational, back-up LB	OLB	6'1	233	MARYLAND
