5	ERIC BERRY	You just knew I was going to praise this Pick. Drafting the next ED REED cannot be a bad thing. BERRY can do anything asked of him... including playing CB. But they need to define his role right away and put him on the field to play.	S	6	210	TENNESSEE
36	DEXTER McCLUSTER	I still think this is way too early for a limited role player. I realize he is a big play waiting to happen at any time, but he also has limitations as a pro because of his size. Early in Round 2 is a reach, especially for a team struggling to avoid 10 losses.	WR/RS	5'9	170	OLE MSS
50	JAVIER ARENAS	Once again, I like the player, but am not impressed with his Value at the Pick. His lack of height will hinder him at times as a pro. He will help the competition level at CB, and at least be a Nickel Corner, but they need starters in R2. His Return ability will help.	CB/RS	5'9	197	ALABAMA
68	JON ASAMOAH	This guy is nice mix of a smart, athletic player who only lacks bulk. If he can prove he is strong enough to play at this size he could be special. He does have skills as both a pass and run blocker.	OG	6'4	305	ILLINOIS
93	TONY MOEAKI	If MOEAKI had been able to stay healthy in college he would have been in high demand here. But this is a roll of the dice, assuming that he will stay healthier in the NFL than he did in college.	TE	6'3	245	IOWA

142	CAMERON SHEFFIELD	SHEFFIELD is another TROY DE, who will attempt to convert to a pass-rushing OLB, ala DeMarcus Ware. He isn't going to be the next WARE, but he has a chance to play in their 3-4 Scheme.	OLB	6'2	255	TROY
