43	SERGIO KINDLE	Because of concerns about a possible micro-fracture issue he lasted until R2. A nice stroke of luck for the RAVENS. I see no reason why he can't turn into the kind of Pro ORAKPO has.	OLB	6'4	250	TEXAS
57	TERRENCE CODY	Another nice present for a team that doesn't have a vet NT under the age of 30. He will be a run-stopping role player, but that plays to his strength and should suit the RAVENS D to a Tee. 70	ED DICKSON	I see no reason why this guy can't step right in, serve an apprenticeship to TODD HEAP and have his role by the 2011 season. If he can pick up some more blocking skills & gain some strength he could be a future Pro Bowl candidate.	TE	6'4	250	OREGON
